# Why México?

The investment in Wind Energy already exceeds **5,000 million dollars**. The objective for 2020-2022 is that the installed capacity in the country is at least **40% of the renewable energy target** (AMDEE, 2018).

The 42 Wind Parks of Mexico are located in the states of Oaxaca, Baja California, Chiapas, Jalisco, Tamaulipas, San Luis Potosi, Nuevo Leon, Puebla and Zacatecas.



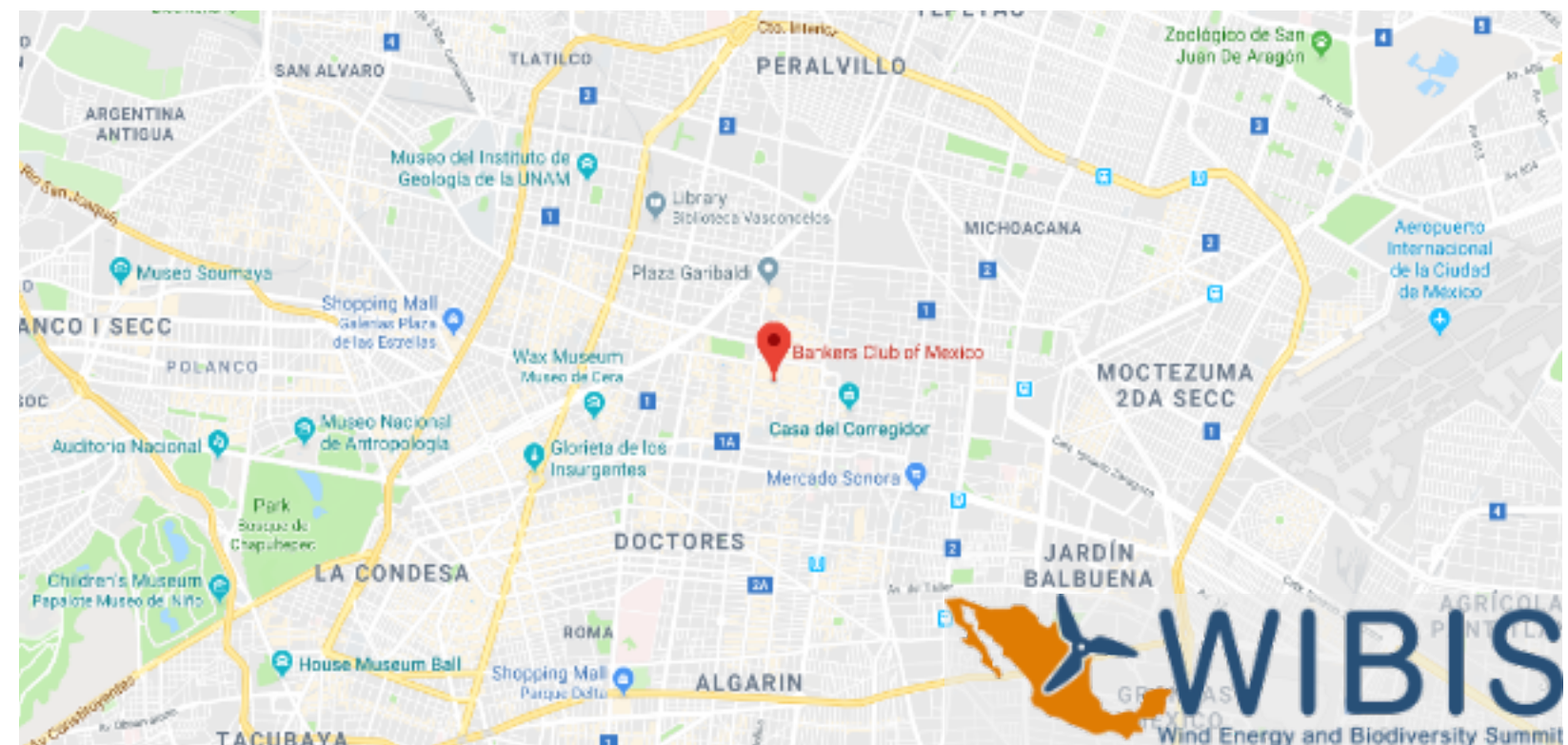
Map adapted from AMDEE (2018): Total Energy planned in 2016, 3,876 MW.
